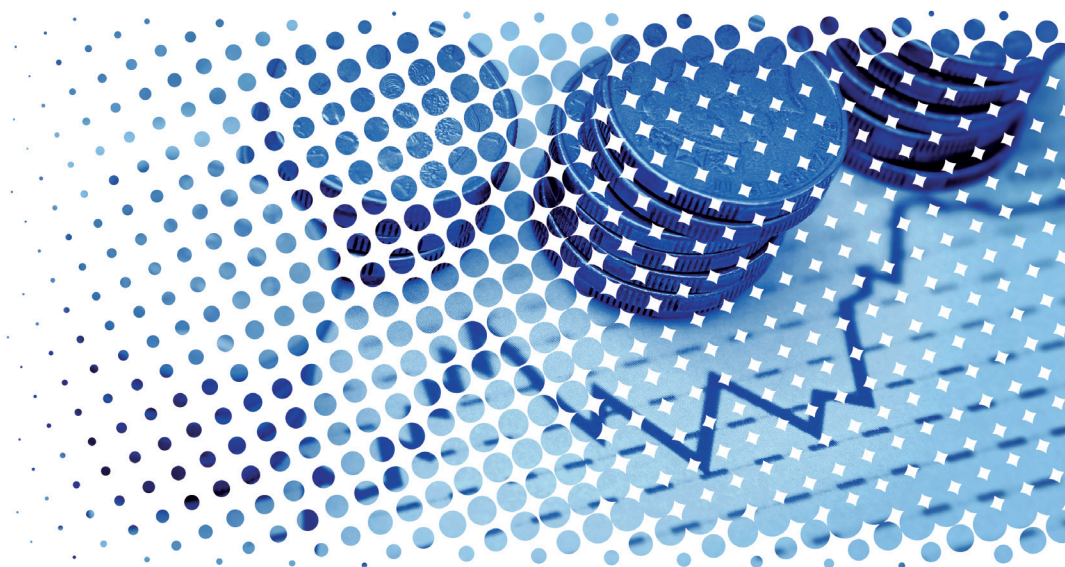

## Searching:

Keep your searches broad and then refine them to find the most relevant funding opportunities

- 1 The three tabs show the active/inactive opportunities and awarded grants matching your search terms
- 2 Refine your search by subject area, sponsor name and country, deadline, and restrictions amongst others
- 3 Create email alerts to be notified of new opportunities related to your research interests

Hint: Awarded grant history can be a relevant indicator for future funding allocations. Use the data here to see which funding bodies are sponsoring research in your area of interest.
